



North America Camping Club Program Rules

North America Camping Club (NACC) administers a nationwide camping club whereby members may visit affiliated campgrounds and pay reduced fees for overnight Recreational Vehicle (RV) camping. The membership offered is a one-year membership that may be renewed annually upon its expiration by paying the then current annual membership fee. The Program Rules are specified below.

1. NACC members may make reservations on a space available basis at any of the affiliated parks. Customer Service Specialists are available 9 AM to 9 PM seven days a week East Coast time to take reservations. Reservations can be made up to 60 days in advance by calling 866-885-NACC (6222). The NACC rate may not be available if a reservation is not made at least 24 hours in advance.
2. NACC members with a reservation confirmation will pay a nightly fee of up to 50% off the affiliated park's prevailing published rate for RV hookups. NACC members without a reservation (drive-up accommodations) may be subject to pay the park's full nightly rate.
3. NACC members may stay up to 14 consecutive nights (or longer if approved by the park on a case-by-case basis). Upon departure, members may return to that park once they have been away an equal number of nights that they stayed at the park.
4. Each park allocates only a certain percentage of sites for NACC Member use. Therefore, NACC rates may not be available even though the park may have available sites.
5. Reservations may be cancelled at least 1 day in advance of their scheduled arrival. A \$25 no-show fee will apply if a reservation is not fulfilled or not cancelled at least one day in advance.
6. A refundable \$25 reservation deposit is required in order to make reservations. Refunds of reservation deposits are processed monthly. Refund requests must be in writing and mailed to: NACC Membership Processing Center, P.O. Box 150, Valentines, VA 23887. A \$5 administration fee will be imposed.
7. The NACC rate at affiliated parks is for two persons. Additional people, pets, or equipment may incur other fees.

8. Water and sewer hookups may not be available depending upon various circumstances such as time of year, park capacity, infrastructure, etc. Other fees that are applicable to other affiliate park guests, such as mandatory cable TV charges, will be applicable to NACC members.
9. Affiliate parks may designate the specific RV site for use by the NACC member.
10. NACC members must adhere to all NACC rules and individual affiliate park rules. Violation of rules may result in forfeiture of the NACC membership.
11. NACC members will be issued a membership card. A \$5 fee will apply for replacement of a lost membership card.
12. The purchase price of a NACC membership is not refundable. A reinstatement fee of \$50 will apply in order to renew a NACC membership that has expired for more than 30 days. Reservation deposits remaining on expired memberships will be forfeited if a refund request is not received within 30 days after the membership expiration date.
13. A NACC membership may be suspended or terminated for the following reasons:
 - a. Non-payment of any fee, charge or other obligation to NACC or any affiliate park.
 - b. Violation of any NACC rules, affiliate park rules, or disorderly conduct at an affiliate park.
 - c. Abuse of NACC or affiliate park employees or damage to equipment or facilities.
 - d. Commission of a criminal offense while at an affiliate park.
 - e. Loaning the NACC membership card to anyone.
14. NACC members are responsible for their guests. Members and guests use the affiliate parks at their own risk.
15. Affiliate park management and employees are not subject to the individual direction or control of NACC or its members. NACC member complaints, comments and suggestions must be sent to NACC in writing, and not to any park employee.
16. The NACC program rules and conditions of use may be updated from time to time at NACC's discretion, and use of the NACC membership implies member agreement with the program rules.
17. The NACC rate is not available on the following 3-day weekends: Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day. The NACC rate is not available in Canada on the following 3-day weekends: Canada Day (July 1), National Heritage Day or New Brunswick Day (first Monday in August), and Labour Day.
18. A membership in NACC provides use at its affiliated parks subject to the NACC Program rules and the affiliate park rules. A NACC membership does not convey any ownership interest in any land or recreational facility, nor does it grant or confer any management

rights over such facilities. A NACC membership does not entail ownership of stock, or an ownership interest in a company or corporation. Membership in NACC does not make the member responsible for any indebtedness, taxes, or other liabilities incurred by NACC.

19. NACC assumes no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any damage resulting from reservations that are cancelled or not fulfilled due to acts of nature or circumstances beyond NACC's reasonable control.
20. Campgrounds affiliate with NACC on a voluntary basis and, therefore, the park directory may change and evolve continuously. NACC makes no representations or warranties with respect to the continued affiliation, number, or quality of any parks affiliated with NACC.
21. Each NACC member agrees to indemnify and hold NACC harmless from and against all claims, liabilities, losses and expenses (including attorneys fees) incurred by reason of damage or injury to any person or property, arising in any manner whatsoever from use by member, member's family or guests of the NACC membership, NACC program, or affiliate park. Further, in the event of any negligence, default or material breach by NACC, the total liability of NACC, if any, shall be limited to the member's right to cancel his membership and receive a pro-rated refund for the unexpired portion of the term.
22. Renewal of a NACC membership is voluntary.
